ESAA CE Finals Volunteer Job Descriptions 2023

Gate: 2 persons for each of 2 shifts as per schedule.

It will be slow at first, then the bulk of people will arrive, after which it will slacken off until a point where everyone who is coming will have arrived. (With combined events all competitors have to be there in time for their first event. On Saturday, there are also walk athletes who will arrive later, and Sunday there will be wheelchair athletes who arrive later. Sunday is an earlier starting time for Senior Boys.

- a. All officials and volunteers should enter via main reception
- b. All competing athletes, team managers, coaches and spectators should enter via gate.
- c. All athletes and team managers should have an entry ticket see example.
- d. Programme £1.00 Check prices for 2023
- e. Adult entry £2.00
- f. Concessions (Children & Over 60s) £1.00 (£1.00)
- g. Coaches with their coach accreditation Free Entry
- h. ALL ENTRIES ARE FOR 2 DAYS
- i. Give a raffle ticket to all who pay for their re-entry on same day or second day.

Reception: 1/2 persons for each of 2 shifts as per schedule

- a. Direct all officials into laned area of Sports Hall, probably via outside door.
- b. Direct all volunteers (see list) into near left hand corner of Sports Hall.
- c. Volunteers and their parents to have free entry.
- d. Direct all spectators, team managers, athletes and others to main gate.

Volunteer Organiser and lunches: 1 person, as per schedule.

a. Check in volunteers, give them their packed lunch, and send off as appropriate.

Results Runner and Results Display: 1 person as per schedule (could be 2 for company)

Based in or near the commentary box

- a. Collect paper slips from judges and timekeepers; take to recorders.
- b. Display results in plastic wallets on outside results board (guillotine edge first)
- c. Display results on inside wall of Sports Hall (blu tack).
- d. Do not display final results until after the results have been announced
- e. Place end of day results on table in Sports Hall. (see also d. above)
- f. Do not be delayed by people wanting to see the results before you put them up.

Field Event Support: 2 per age group (one per each pool in age group)

- a. Report to your event/pool team at the start of the day and again before the start of each event. You will have breaks between events and may spectate or assist with something else at this time
- b. They will tell you how they would like you to help with each event.
- c. You will be out on the field and must have warm and, preferably waterproof clothing.
